*2012 AFM Budget

Pat noted that the premium for \$100,000 of liability coverage for the Board of Directors was \$45 per annum; this is the maximum for which we are able to qualify due to the way in which the Board is comprised. Other items on the proposed budget remain as presented last month. Last year (2011), only the property casualty and worker's insurance line item went over budget; Finance Committee has allocated more to this expense in 2012 to reflect an actual increase in its cost.

A Friend noted his discomfort with the idea of insurance, and the fact that "insurance" was the largest line item in our budget (15% of the total AFM budget). He has chosen to stand aside from the approval of the 2012 budget. Another Friend suggested that Finance Committee examine the relative cost of raising the deductable. The Clerk asked for volunteers to examine this cost but found none willing to do this. Finance Committee will report back with the amount of current insurance deductibles.

December contributions resulted in contributions for the 2011 year exceeding our projected budget by \$1064. AFM thanks all who have supported the financial need of the Meeting.

With one Friend (Steve Livingston) standing aside, Friends approved the 2012 AFM budget.

Finance Committee noted that they did not have time to explore other options for banks or credit unions to hold our funds. Please contact Finance Committee if you are able to do this. Friends noted that the North Carolina State Employees Credit Union could hold our monies if at least half of our members had accounts, or were eligible to have accounts, with SECU.

*Nominating Committee – Katherine Kowal

The committee nominated Jen Rhode Ward to the M&C committee. A Friend asked how many persons would serve on M&C. It will still be 6.

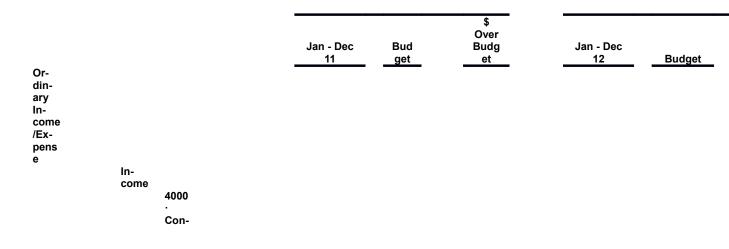
Friends approved Jen Rhode Ward's membership on the Ministry & Counsel Committee.
